THE BLIND MAN SEES JESUS

In today's Gospel the disciples enter into a discussion with Jesus:

What's the reason for the blind man's affliction? Is it the result of sin – his or his parents? Jesus rejects the notion his contemporaries and some of us might have: the man is not being punished because he sinned. Jesus doesn't propose an explanation for all the evil in the world. Instead, he addresses the needs of the man in front of him. The



man's healing will reveal God's active presence in our world. "Neither he nor his parents sinned; it is so that the works of God might be made visible through him."

As it turns out, God's works manifested through the man's cure aren't "seen' by his parents, his neighbours, nor the Pharisees. They don't see what God has done. Nor does the blind man immediately understand what happened to him. He comes to insight about Jesus only after he is repeatedly questioned by the authorities and then has an "eye-opening" conversation with Jesus.

Isn't it strange that the neighbours didn't recognize the blind man once he got his sight? Jesus opened his eyes; he didn't perform plastic surgery and change the man's features! These were his neighbours, not strangers. They would have passed him daily. Had they only seen his infirmity and not the person? Don't we tend to describe people by their infirmities? The cripple... the blind woman... the Corona virus patient, etc.?

But Jesus sees and stops by "the man blind from birth." He not only cures him, but later seeks him out, draws him into a



conversation that brings him to faith. Jesus doesn't see the affliction only, but the person in need. Maybe we had better take a second and third look at those on the edges of our social circle and world to see the person who also happens to be crippled, socially awkward, homeless, etc. We might be the blind person

and by paying attention to persons and not just their afflictions, our eyes might be opened and we too led to seeing Jesus.

For each of us this Lent Jesus is passing by, sees our condition and stops to heal us. We probably are like last week's woman at the well and today's blind man: we come to "see" who Jesus is slowly and in stages. Note, the blind man starts by naming, "the man called Jesus," then he calls him "a prophet, then he recognizes him as the one sent by God and finally calls Jesus "Lord."

NOW WHAT? ONLINE MASS AND OTHER RESOURCES

During these unprecedented times, quite painfully, many Catholics will be unable to attend Mass. No doubt, this will only increase our hunger for Christ. We encourage you to continue your life of prayer and participation in the life of the Church despite this heavy cross.

On 18 March 2020, after prayerful consideration and reflection, the Bishops of Victoria announced the suspension of public liturgies and celebrations of Mass, until further notice for the health and safety of the community. In light of this, all Catholics in Victoria are dispensed from their Sunday obligation until further notice (canon 1248).

If you are unable to be present at a celebration of the Eucharist, we encourage you to participate in other ways such as spending time in personal and family prayer, reflecting on and praying with the Scriptures (particularly the <u>Mass readings</u>), making a Stations of the Cross, praying the Rosary, making an Act of Spiritual Communion (see below) and participating in Mass online (see more below).

Catholics have long been encouraged to partake in the practice of "spiritual communion" if they are unable to receive the Eucharist for a particular reason (for instance – being homebound). Simply put, it is coming before God in prayer – expressing our deep desire to be united to Him despite the fact that we are unable to be united to Him in receiving the Eucharist. In making an Act of Spiritual Communion we ask the Lord to give us the graces that would come to us if we were able to receive Him sacramentally (Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity). Reciting the prayer written by St. Alphonsus Liguori below is simple and common way of making an act of of Spiritual Communion.

An Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.

Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You.

Amen.
